Brown City Schools will be providing Title I services in Reading, Math, Science, and Social Studies for Kindergarten through twelfth grade students. This Title I program will supplement the regular core academic programs in the regular classroom. Students will be selected for Title I services as a result of building level assessments, overall classroom performance, and /or teacher recommendations. Students recommended will receive assistance in the content area in which there is an academic need.

A teacher or paraprofessional within the school building will be conducting this program. The program will provide additional assistance and support services to eligible students throughout the school day. Staff may work with all students while in the regular education classroom, however special attention will be given to Title I eligible students. Progress reports and other evaluations will continue to come from the child's regular classroom teacher. At any given time you have the right to request the professional qualifications of your child's teacher or paraprofessional.

Your child may be recommended as a student who would benefit from additional assistance from the Title I services during the current school year. If you **do not** wish to have this additional assistance for your child if they qualify or are recommended, please sign and return this form.
